Project History

- •The creation of the Mountain Parkway was a significant milestone for Kentucky's transportation system.
- •It opened in 1963 as one of the state's first toll roads, which created high-speed routes beyond the interstate highway system that was being expanded during that era.
- •The Mountain Parkway provided a modern connection for commerce and travel between rural areas of Eastern Kentucky, and more populous areas in Central Kentucky and beyond.





Project Overview

- In January 2014, Gov. Steve Beshear announced plan to fulfill the original promise of making the entire parkway four lanes.
- Length: 45-mile expansion
 - 32 miles of existing parkway widened to four lanes (Campton to Salyersville)
 - 13 miles of additional parkway constructed/ expanded to four lanes (Salyersville to Prestonsburg)





Project Impacts

- The Mountain Parkway Expansion is an investment in the communities of Eastern Kentucky.
- By improving the infrastructure throughout Eastern Kentucky, we make the Appalachian region a more attractive place for future companies to establish and grow their businesses.
- Wider roads provide easier access for trucks to travel across the state, enhancing the potential for freight companies to conduct business in this region.




Project Impacts


 The Mountain Parkway serves as Eastern Kentucky's connection to the rest of the Commonwealth.
 We're widening and enhancing that connection to make sure that wherever you go, you get there safely.





- The purpose of the last segment is to extend the parkway from US 460 in Salyersville to near the KY 114/KY 404 intersection in Floyd County.
- This will be along the preferred cross-country alignment as a four-lane, controlled access parkway.
- The Magoffin-Floyd segment is the first segment of the project using the design-build approach.

- J. Davis Law Firm, PLLC will also assist with workforce development, on the job training activities, and coordination with design team staff, consultants, and advisors.









DBE VS. MBE



DBE/ACDBE

- Implemented on Federal level by USDOT
- Program is designed to remedy ongoing discrimination and the continuing effects of past discrimination in federally-assisted highway, transit, airport, and highway safety
- Certification is through the State DOT

MBE/ MWBE

- Implemented on the State Level
- Designed to remedy ongoing discrimination in state, county, and city projects.
- Includes building of schools, convention centers, city developments, and other state, local or city funded projects.
- Certification is typically through State Department of Finance Administration

DBE PROGRAM OVERVIEW

- Every State that receive USDOT Federal Funds Must have a DBE Program.
- USDOT and FHWA provide oversight
- 49CFR Part 26
- Codified by the Civil Rights Act of 1964
- Applicable to every state



DBE PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- Social Disadvantage Black Americans, Asian-Pacific, Asian-Indian, Hispanic Americans, Native Americans, Women.
- Economic Disadvantage Less than \$2.047 million Personal Net worth
- Ownership 51%, Looks at Initial Investment
- Control Management and Expertise
- Small Business Administration Requirements
- Must Be For Profit



DBE CERTIFICATION PROCESS

- DBE Application
- From the date you submit a complete application, KYTC has 90 days to process your application (30 days for interstate)
- Onsite Review at the place of business and interview of owner
- DBE Committee reviews the application and determines eligibility
- Listed on KYTC official directory
- Annual Affidavit of No change
- Certification reviewed every three years

- Uniform Certification Application with supporting documentation
- Affidavit of Certification- Notarized
- Personal Net Worth Statement-Notarized
- If something that does not apply respond-N/A
- Do not submit original documentation



DBE DOCUMENTATION

- Resumes
- Proof of presumed social disadvantage
- Signed Personal tax returns (last three years)
- Signed Applicant Firm tax returns (last three years)
- Each owner must submit proof of ownership
- Real Estate Holdings
- Lease agreements (equipment and facilities)
- Titles and proof of insurance for equipment and vehicles
- NAICS codes applicable to requested services



DBE DOCUMENTATION

DBE SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION (CONT.)

- Documented transfers for the past two (2) years
- Year end balance sheet for the past three
 (3) years
- Relevant licenses, renewal forms and haul authority forms
- Other certifications
- Bank authorization and signatory cards
- Payroll documentation
- Trust agreements
- Spousal Affidavit (if applicable)





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


CERTIFIED BY NAICS CODE

North American Industry Classification System

- Six-digit numerical code used to classify businesses based on the type of good or service they provide
- DBE Certification requires that you be assigned a specific code for each type of good or service provided
- It is important to maintain proper codes because it could potentially affect DBE goal setting.
- If your business picks up additional lines of work along the way you and request to add codes (49 C.F.R. § 26.71(n))

DBE Informational and Marketing

- The session will take place approximately 90 days prior to the Construction Phase at a date, time, and location that accommodates DBEs.
- All interested Kentucky DBEs will be notified of the meeting and provided a link to join by Zoom if they cannot attend the meeting in person.
- Prior to the meeting, the DBT will identify potential areas of work for DBE Construction Phase participation. The notice for the meeting will provide this information.
- The meeting will be for the purpose of providing details on the subcontracting opportunities, ways to access bidding information, points of contact to answer questions, requirements to submit quotes, timelines for proposal responses, and to identify assistance the DBE may request.


